School PE kit is: burgundy t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms, school jumper.



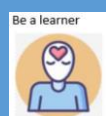
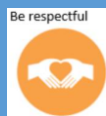
Thank you for all of your support with Times Tables Rock Stars Day! It was a great success, and the costumes were impressive!!
