Core Values

Children will be awarded Dojo points based around our four core values. The children can redeem these points at the Dojo shop each half term.



What are we learning this term?

Our topic explores 'Growing'. We will be learning all about plants, how to grow them and look after them in Science. In Maths, we will revisit calculation strategies, position and direction, as well as problem solving strategies. In Geography, we will be learning how to communicate geographically and focus on mapping skills. Our focus in Life Skills is about 'My Rights and Responsibilities' and in RE we'll explore; 'Religious Stories'.

Reading and Phonics

Children will focus on a particular book for the week. They will participate in reading and writing activities surrounding this book.

Your child will be sent home with a 'Book Bag' book which will

be similar to the story they have focused on during the week. We would expect you to listen to your child read, and encourage they read like a story teller with expression.

They will also bring a library book of their choosing to share with you.
