School PE kit is: burgundy t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms, school jumper.

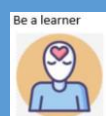
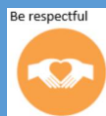


Please send in a named drinks bottle. Bottles sent into school for children's drinks **MUST** only contain water.
