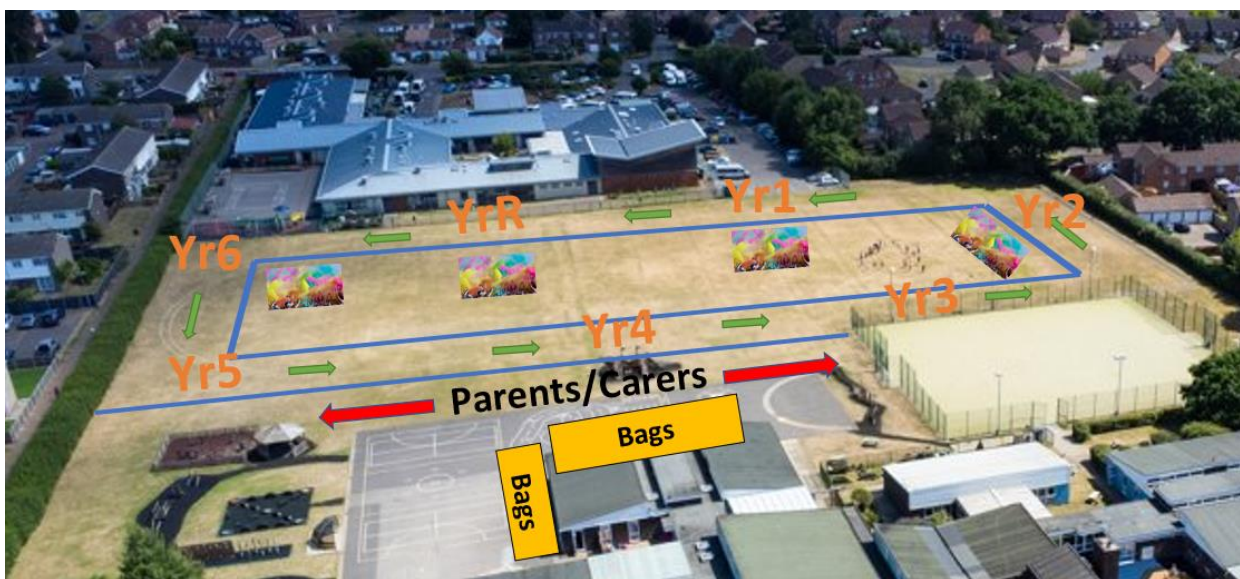

Parents and Carers,

We are excited about our very first Colour Run, which will take place this Friday 13th June on the school field. This is sure to be a fun and vibrant event for our children! We would like to share some important information to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Parents are welcome to join us from 1:30pm, but please note that the gates will close promptly at 1:45pm. Unfortunately, the school office will be closed during this time, so please plan accordingly. Additionally, we regret to inform you that toilet facilities will not be available for parents at the event. Please see the layout of the school field with the plan for the afternoon.



As the children will be getting colourful and messy, we kindly ask that they wear clothes that you do not mind getting messy. We will provide each child with a white T-shirt before heading outside, so no need to bring additional clothing. We suggest you send your child only with the essentials: a water bottle, a packed lunch if required, sunscreen, and a hat, as the weather is looking quite promising. Also, do remember that goggles or sunglasses are recommended for everyone's safety and comfort!

For those who wish, there will be a delicious special feast on the field meal available for the children, featuring a choice of a Hot Dog or Vegetable Hot Dog with Tomato Ketchup, Chips, Cucumber Sticks, and an Iced Sprinkle Cupcake. This will be at a cost of £2.70, unless your child is entitled to free school meals.
