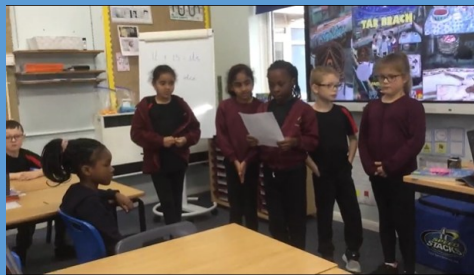
## Newsletter 2
